### **INTEGRATION OF CROSS-CUTTING ISSUES**

The College is affiliated to **Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon** and adheres to the curriculum prepared by the expert body consisting of teachers from various institutions. The teachers try to inculcate human values and professional ethics in the students with the help of curriculum and extracurricular activities. The curriculum integrates the issues like The institution regularly tries to integrate these cross-cutting social issues to the curriculum by periodically organizing seminars/ workshops having bearing on Gender Equality, Environment and Sustainability, Human Values and Professional Ethics. The college also recognizes the importance of value based education. Human Values are, admittedly, most precious of all values. Communal Harmony, dignity of Labor and concern for the others are human Values that the institution tries to inculcate in the minds of the receivers.

There are specific committees and associations like Women Empowerment Cell (Yuvati Sabha) that make a collective effort to sensitize the students on areas of concern like Gender equality, Human rights, Environmental issues, etc. The general atmosphere of our college, with equal opportunity to boys and girls in many courses, provides an enabling environment for gender equality. Gender equality is promoted through lectures on women rights, female feticide and gender based violations. Self defense courses for girls, skits promoting gender sensitivity and other such related activities are also organized. The college promotes green practices through plantation in botanical garden. The NSS unit of the college strives to establish a bond with the community at large through awareness rallies on current social issues.



The college organizes following activities:

1. Human Values and Professional Ethics: Human values and ethics are the part of the syllabi. A handbook of Human Values and Professional Ethics is available on the college website. The copies of the manual in hard copies have been kept in the department and the library. Students are sensitized through various activities. The college takes efforts for integration of ethical and human values through extra-curricular activities also. Programs conducted under N. S. S., Red Ribbon Club, Student Development cell and department help to inculcate human values among students. Guest lectures on value education have been organized for students. National festivals like Independence Day and Republic Day serve as a platform to enliven patriotic and moral values. Different social activities have been initiated by the college like Health and Hygiene awareness programs, Medical check-up camps, AIDS awareness programs, Voter's awareness program, Road safety Campaign, Blood donation camps, etc.

Gender Sensitization: 'Yuvati Sabha' is the Special Cell in operation to carry out various activities for women students. Various activities conducted for women and girl students include Self-Defense training, hemoglobin, HIV and Sickle cell check up camps, zero tolerance policy for sexual harassment. Prevention against Sexual Harassment and and internal complaint committee organizes programs on Woman Empowerment, Laws for Woman, Women's Day, The N.S.S. unit of our college has been very proactive in conducting different extension activities not only in college premises but also in adopted villages also. Major gender issues are focused and addressed through the activities like save-girl child campaign, Essay and poster exhibitions, wall paper presentations, etc.

2. Environment and Sustainability: The college promotes environmental protection through tree plantation and other sustainable development programs. Every year, N.S.S. unit undertakes a host of activities in the nearby villages during the special camps. In these camps, N.S.S. organizes various environment related programs including tree plantation, village cleanliness, digging of soak peats, eradication of harmful grass, plastic free drive, Poster Competition, Debate Competition, etc. Various activities like



quiz and poster competitions, invited talks are organized to create awareness about nature, biodiversity, environment and sustainability. Different activities have been initiated by the college to save environment such as Cleanliness Campaigns at sacred places, Bus and Public spaces etc. The cleanliness program is organized to clean ponds, watering plant, Celebration of various days like World Environment Day, N.S.S. Day, etc


